A1: The second person can be registered as 'the presenter to an outstanding presentation' in the first lot. We are encouraging the supporters to offer a unique product of their own as an award to a poster presentation. It may be an equipment for field work, a publication or a yearly membership of your organization. The supporters are free to specify a topic or category to give the award to.

A3: The exhibition booths will be allocated in either the drink corner or the foyer where lots of people pass by. The booth set-up will be the afternoon of July 26 and the removal the afternoon of July 30.

A4: The optional items can be hired and arranged via the PCO of the Congress. The details will be given in May 2015.
